Conference on Soul-Winning

(Pro 11:30) **“The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise.”**

We recently had Pastor Jeff Johnson, of the Hispanic Gospel Light Baptist Church in Winston Salem, NC. Brother Johnson has an Hispanic church with an average attendance of over eight hundred on Sunday mornings. We invited him with the specific purpose in mind of encouraging our people in the matter of soul-winning. He did an excellent job and the Lord used him greatly through the preaching of the Word to fire up our people in this all important matter.

Not only did he encourage us through instruction and illustrations but also accompanied us going door to door. I wanted the men to hear someone else besides me doing it so that they might learn even more. That afternoon we had two precious souls saved. I had two men with me that were not used to seeing someone get saved at the door. She first told us she was trusting in her good works to get her to heaven. After I showed her how she could be saved she put her faith in the Lord Jesus. When I asked her the second time how she would respond

to God if He were to ask her why He should let her into Heaven, she said because I trusted in Him and both Hispanic men simultaneously let out a big AMEN! It was exciting to see.

I was out with a few of the young people soul-winning and seeing three young Hispanics walking we stopped to talk with them. When I began to share the gospel with Cesar, he pointed to Jeremiah, (one of our youth) and said that he had already been talking to him about his need to be saved. Praise the Lord! What a testimony of one of our young people that had already been witnessing for the Lord Jesus. The good news is just a couple of weeks later Cesar and two of his friends put their trust in the Lord.

I was out soul-winning with one of our teens, and we

prayed that the Lord would lead us to other teens. Going door to door, after having just shared the gospel with four men from El Salvador, we knocked on a door. A young man, 16 opened the door, and seated in the front room were six young people, all of which were sixteen or seventeen years of age. I shared the Good News with them and though no one was saved, the door is opened to return and have more studies with them.

Recently I started a soul-winning class and the men are excited! They are learning the Plan of Salvation, memorizing Scripture and praying. I also have them listening to Hispanic preachers on the topic of soul-winning and other themes. As I did in Mexico I will train them to the point tht they can in turn train others. (2Timothy 2:2) **“And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.”** (Emphasis mine)

Please pray for the many family members of the people attending the church now, some of which live here and some in other countries, whether Mexico or South America. One couple in particular are praying and fasting for their parents in Leon, Guanajuato, while they witness to them by phone. We also have a missionary in that city in contact with them.
