He made that decision on a Tuesday and the next day presented it to the church during their Wednesday evening service. The church agreed to step out on faith and send all of the support. When they counted the offering that night after the service, a believer, who had not been in a few weeks, had put in \$36,000 pesos. Praise the Lord! That gave them enough to be able to send all the support to all the missionaries and pay the rent on the building. The following Sunday, another family put in \$10,000 pesos. Isn't the Lord good! The faith, not just of the pastor, but of the church grew exceedingly!

They had canceled their missions conference, because of the coronavirus, but still stepped out on faith and took on 4 new missionaries, bringing their total to 40 missionaries. Thank God for a pastor that was willing to lead his church together to try their faith and to prove God's promise!
